The Chief David G. Bailey Fire Science Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 in loving memory of David G. Bailey. Chief Bailey had a passion for fire service and believed strongly in teaching others who choose to serve their community as volunteer fire fighters.

Dave joined the Cherry Valley Fire Department on April 14, 1964. He worked his way through the ranks, becoming District Chief in October 1975. He held this position until his death. He was a member of Winnebago Fire Chiefs Association where he served as secretary/treasurer in 1973 and president 1974-75. Dave was a charter member and originator of Northern Illinois Arson Task Force. He helped

develop MABAS, Division 8 (Mutual Aid Box Alarm System), serving as president since January 1982. Dave was a member of Winnebago County Water Rescue & Recovery Team, Southern Wisconsin and Northern Illinois Fire/Rescue Association, Illinois Fire Chiefs Association, International Fire Chiefs Association and National Fire Protection District Association.

Dave was well known for his enormous heart and tremendous love of the fire service. His pride and dedication shined bright through the firefighters that served under his leadership. Dave's traditions and values are carried out to this day through the Cherry Valley Fire Protection District and those fortunate enough to have known him.

CHIEF DAVID G. BAILEY FIRE SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicants must be firefighters, age 18 or older, currently serving in one of the following areas:
 - a. Cherry Valley Fire Protection District
 - b. M.A.B.A.S. (Mutual Aid Box Alarm System) Division 8 Fire Departments both primary and secondary members
 - c. Kirkland, IL or
 - d. Any other fire department within Boone, Ogle, Stephenson or Winnebago County.
- 2. Funds must be used for tuition for an accredited, sanctioned or certified course relating to fire science and/or emergency medical services training and may include seminars and workshops. The applicant's commanding officer must approve courses as being pertinent to the needs of the Department.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Recipients will be selected by a committee consisting of the Cherry Valley Fire Protection District Chief, the M.A.B.A.S. District 8 President and a representative of the family of Chief David G. Bailey.
- 2. Applications are reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.

 - b. Letter of recommendation from your Fire Chief.
 - c. A narrative of approximately 300 words that describes your future educational/career goals and how this coursework will assist you.
