

Providing education resources to well-rounded students from Winnebago County entering technology fields

APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a permanent resident of Winnebago County;
- Be a current college freshman;
- Have a GPA of at least 3.0/4.0;
- Be enrolled in a field of study related to technology, such as computer science, engineering, or applied sciences;
- Participate in a number of extracurricular activities; and
- Have an EFC of less than 10,000.

DEADLINE: FEBRUARY I

SPECIFICATIONS:

- The scholarship will be renewed at the same yearly amount for up to two additional years if the recipient has a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/4.0 at the end of each year and continues to major in an appropriate technology field.
- In order to receive subsequent year awards, recipients are required to submit a progress report and transcript at the end of the year. The progress report will include a self-evaluation of what they have learned and how they anticipate benefitting from the next year of coursework. The report should be a maximum of 500 words in length.
- Eligible incumbent students will be given priority for scholarship awards. No new scholarships will be awarded until all eligible incumbent students have been awarded renewals and additional funds remain.
