## APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a graduate or a graduating high school senior from a public high school in Winnebago or Boone Counties;
- Have a permanent address in Winnebago or Boone Counties;
- Graduating seniors must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or above, while current college students must have a cumulative collegiate GPA of 3.5 or above;
- Exhibit financial need (an EFC of 3,000 or less); and
- Be actively involved in social studies organizations, clubs and classes such as student government, political campaigns, community organizing or advocacy.

*The scholarship is non-renewable, but past recipients can reapply.  
The deadline is February 1.*
