Applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior or a student who has graduated from high school;
- Have a permanent residence in NSDAR District 2*;
- Attend or plans to attend the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in the upcoming school year;
- Have a GPA of at least 3.0/4.0;
- Have financial need (EFC of no more than 10,000); and
- Demonstrate outstanding leadership, dependability, and citizenship.

** NSDAR's District 2 includes Jo Daviess, Stephenson, Winnebago, Boone, McHenry, Carroll, Ogle, DeKalb, Whiteside, Lee, Bureau, La Salle, Stark, Marshall, Putnam, and Grundy Counties.*

Applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior;
- Be a resident of Winnebago County;
- Have a GPA of at least 3.0/4.0;
- Be pursuing a degree in a conservation-related field; and
- Have financial need (EFC of no more than 10,000).
