## CFNIL FUND ADVISOR PORTAL OVERVIEW

As a Fund Advisor you have access to the Community Foundation of Northern Illinois' online portal where you can view information about your fund(s). CFNIL will send you a link to set up your account and access the portal via email; see the next page for screenshots and text instructions. Once you have created your account, you can access the portal at any time from <u>cfnil.org/fund-advisor</u> or by clicking "Fund Advisor Login" at the top of every page of our website.



This page includes a text overview of what you will see upon accessing the portal. See page 6 for screenshots.

Upon logging in to the portal, if you are an advisor for more than one fund, select the fund for which you'd like to view details. If you are an advisor for only one fund you will be taken directly to the portal Home page.

- Home: Shows the Fund's current balance, a list of all the fund's advisors, a table of recent contributions, and a table of recent grants. Certain types of funds will also see a spendable balance.
- **Choose Fund:** If you are a Fund Advisor for more than one fund, this tab will allow you to select which fund you'd like to view details of.
- **Contributions:** Shows all contributions/donations to the fund. Please note we are still in the process of loading in donations made prior to July I, 2020. If a donor did not mark their gift anonymous you will be able to click on their name and view their history of giving to the fund.
- **Grants:** Shows the history of grants/payments made out of the fund. Please note we are still in the process of loading in donations made prior to July 1, 2020.
- **Statements:** Running table of the fund's quarterly statements, starting with Q3-2020. Click "Print" to view, download, or print a statement.
- **Files:** The Quarterly Statement Letters and Stewardship Summary reports which have been mailed to you each quarter may now be found here. In the future, we may add additional files to this tab such as grantmaking reports, fund agreements, and more.
- Donate: View and make donations to all of CFNIL's funds which are eligible for online giving.
- Logout: Click this tab to log out of your account. We recommend logging out at the end of every session.

#### Locked Out of your Fund Advisor Portal?

If you are locked out of your account, click Forgot Password on the login page. Enter your username and click the Reset Password button. If an account with the provided username is found, instructions to reset your password will be sent to the email address for that account. #### Alerts and Paper Statements: Opting In or Out

Each quarter, you will receive an email alert when a new statement is posted and ready to view in the portal. You also have the option to receive an email alert every time a Donation is made or a Grant is paid out from your Fund. These alerts can be utilized or canceled at any point but are not retroactive, so you will not be notified of past grants or donations. By default, Fund Advisors will continue to receive paper statements by mail unless you notify CFNIL of your desire to stop receiving paper statements. #### Community Foundation of Northern Illinois Stewardship Summary As of: December 31, 2020 CFNIL's investment policy is structured to enhance investment performance, while controlling risk through broad diversification of asset classes, investment strategies, and underlying managers. The chart below reflects the Foundation's most recent asset allocation by asset class. Total Fund performance is also compared to the Policy Index. The Policy Index is a weighted total performance of the underlying target benchmarks for the asset classes in the Total Fund. When the total return of the Fund exceeds the total return of the Policy Index, it indicates that the Foundation's investment managers are collectively outperforming the weighted performance of their respective benchmarks or deviations between the actual and policy allocation have been accretive.
