- Be a graduating high school senior with a permanent address in McHenry or Winnebago Counties (preference will be given to students from McHenry County);
- Intend to major in an engineering field (preference will be given to students studying metallurgical engineering); and
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.25/4.0.

Preference will be given to students attending the following universities: University of Illinois, Illinois State University, Illinois Institute of Technology, University of Iowa, or Colorado School of Mines.
